Parents can open a Child Development Account (CDA) and apply for the Cash Gift for their child by enrolling into the Baby Bonus Scheme online via www.babybonus.msf.gov.sg or the LifeSG mobile application. This is a simple process through which parents can also register for the Baby Bonus Cash Gift and Baby Support Grant. To receive further dollar-for-dollar co-matching from the Government, parents will subsequently need to deposit funds into their eligible child's CDA. Members of the public who require help opening a CDA account can visit MSF's Baby Bonus website (babybonus.msf.gov.sg), or call the Baby Bonus hotline at 1800 253 7707 for assistance.

[^] All Singaporean children who are the second child, and whose date of birth or Estimated Date of Delivery (EDD), is on or after 1 January 2021, will be eligible. Government will co-match parents' savings up to the increased cap from 1 April 2021. Parents whose children qualify and had saved into their child's CDA before 1 April 2021, will also receive the increased co-matching.

*For children whose date of birth or EDD is from 1 October 2020 to 30 September 2022 and are also eligible for the Baby Bonus Cash Gift.
